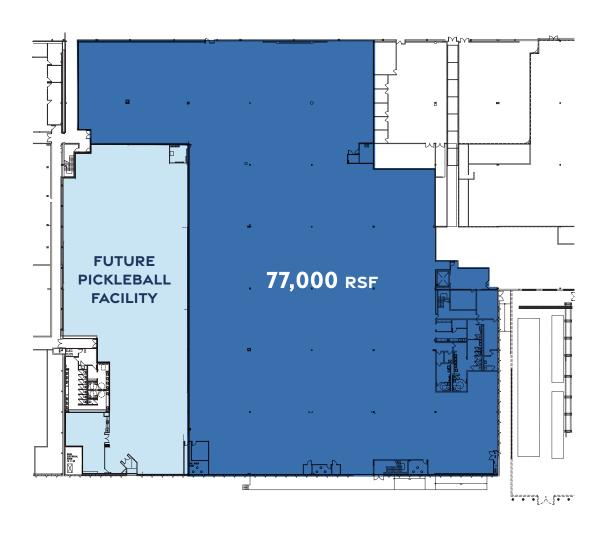


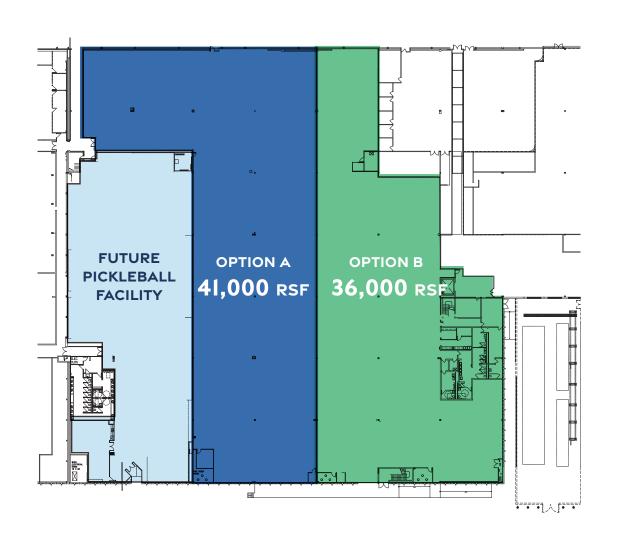

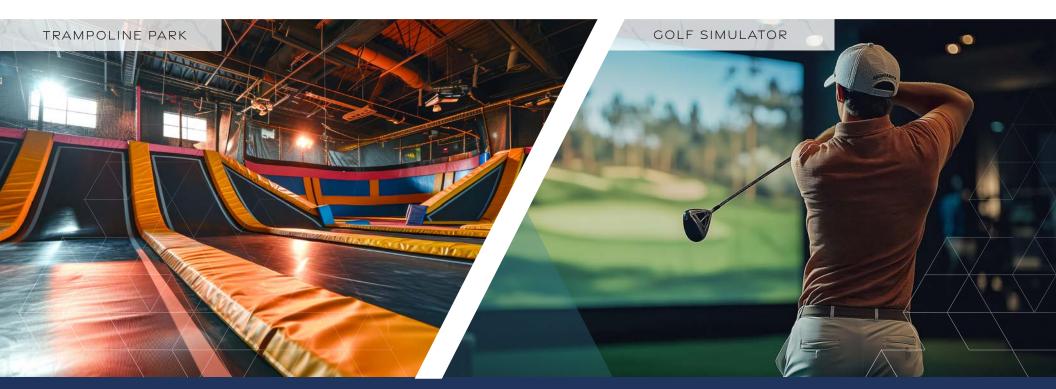


PROPOSED DEMISE SCENARIOS OPTION A: +/-41,000 SF | OPTION B: +/-36,000 RSF

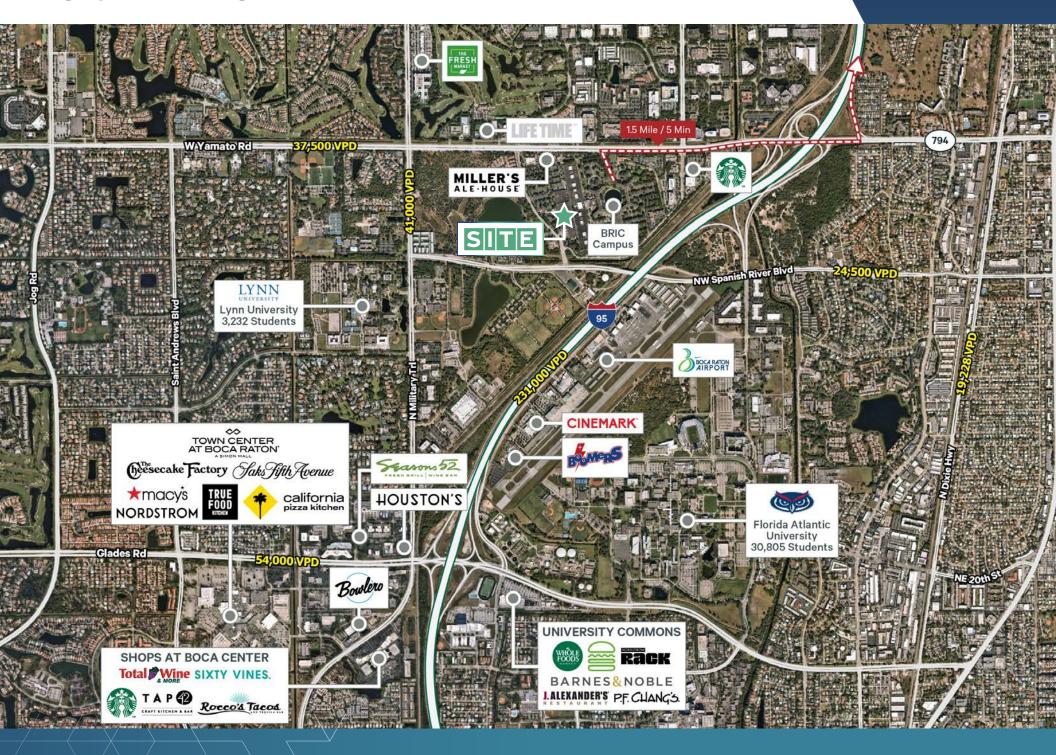
